

Claregate Primary School Outcomes 2019

Performance data for 2022 should not be directly compared with 2019 and earlier. Nor should comparisons be made between schools. This is because schools may have been affected differently by COVID-19.

Early Years Foundation Stage

Children are defined as having reached a “Good Level of Development” (GLD) at the end of Reception Class if they have achieved at least the expected level for the Early Learning Goals in the prime areas of learning and the specific areas of mathematics and literacy. These are : -Communication and Language; Physical Development; Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED); Literacy; Maths; Understanding the World and Expressive Arts and Design.

If children score 32/40 in the phonics check, they are deemed to have passed. The ones who do not pass, still study phonics in Year 2 and sometimes into Key Stage 2.
